Description of Each Session:

ROCK CAMP: Session 1: Kevin Wells, Instructor Session 3: Anthony Melville, Instructor

(Ages 10-16 Only) Session begins Monday-Thursday at 9am and runs until Noon, Friday's performance will be at 7pm and open to the public. Students will learn 4+ songs during each session. Camp will emphasize live performance techniques, working in a band setting, and the rules of rock.

JAZZ CAMP: Session 2 & 5: Matt Rothstein, Instructor

(Ages 12+ Only) Session begins Monday-Thursday at 9am and runs until Noon, Friday's performance will be at 7pm and open to the public. Students will learn 4+ standards during each session. Camp will emphasize the "how to" of learning jazz songs, basic jazz song structure and performance techniques.

ADULT JAZZ CAMP: Session 6: Paula Samonte, Instructor (for jazz vocalists)

(Ages 18+ Only) Session begins Monday-Thursday at 7pm and runs until 9pm, Friday's performance will be at 7pm and open to the public. Students will learn 4+ songs during each session. This class will emphasize the "how to" be a jazz vocalist, performance technique, and presentation. A piano accompanist will be provided. *Additional instrumentalists will be accepted to the class based on ability to solo and accompany pianist.*

ADULT ROCK CAMP: Session 4: TJ Elton, Instructor

(Ages 17+ Only) Session begins Monday-Thursday at 7pm and runs until 9pm, Friday's performance will be at 7pm and open to the public. Students will learn 4+ songs during each session. Camp emphasis is learning to play in a band setting, performance techniques, and 'tricks of the trade'.

GIRLZROCK CAMP: Session 7: Katharine Cole, Instructor

(Ages 10-16 Only) Session begins Monday-Thursday at 9am and runs until Noon, Friday's performance will be at 7pm and open to the public. Students will learn 4+ songs during each session. Camp will emphasize live performance techniques, working together in a band setting, and breaking barriers in the world of rock.

Frequently Asked Questions

All Students need to be at Treblemakers (171A Brush Street, Ukiah) for load-in no later 15 minutes prior to start time to be ready to play! Your instructors will talk with you about what gear requirements you may have once you are accepted. Camp will supply amps, drums, keyboards, a mixer, guitars if needed and most of the gear any student will need to *hit the stage!*

The following are the minimum skills required to attend Camp (by instrument):

GUITAR:

- Play E form and A form bar chords
- Know all names of notes on 5th and 6th strings
- Know all open chord forms
- Can demonstrate an ability to play in time by playing any song they know

BASS:

- Know the names of the notes on the fret board
- Can demonstrate an ability to play in time by playing any song they know

VOCALS:

- Sing in tune
- Sing from diaphragm
- Be outgoing enough to sing in public
- Should be prepared to sing the style of music (rock or jazz) specifically.

DRUMS:

- Play a "four on the floor" beat with snare on 2 and 4 and quarter and eighth notes on high hat
- Play rock beat with kick on 1 and 3 and snare and high hat the same as above
- Be able to fill out of a phrase and land in time
- Can demonstrate an ability to play in time by playing any song they know

KEYBOARDS/BRASS/WOODWINDS:

- Be able to read simple chord charts
- Can demonstrate an ability to play in time by playing any song they know

For our Under 18 Campers: Parents are not permitted to attend Rock or Jazz Camp. The instructors are professionals and will make the best decisions possible for all involved. Any student unable to follow the Rules may face expulsion from Camp and forfeit all session fees.

Q: Who are the Camp teachers?

A: The staff is made up of local professional musicians/instructors from the Treblemakers staff. Each camp will have a different pair of instructors.

Q: What if I'm in a band?

A: Sign up! It's a great way to tighten up what you are already doing and to collectively expand your horizons. You can also use the CD and DVD as promotional material!

Q: What instruments are allowed in Rock & Jazz Camp?

A: Electric Guitar, Bass, Drums, Keyboards and Vocals. (Jazz Camp includes brass & woodwinds in this list!)

Q: Is there any private instruction?

A: There's not really time to take more than a few minutes with you if you're having trouble, so schedule a private lesson with one of our teachers at Treblemakers if you think you need more help.
